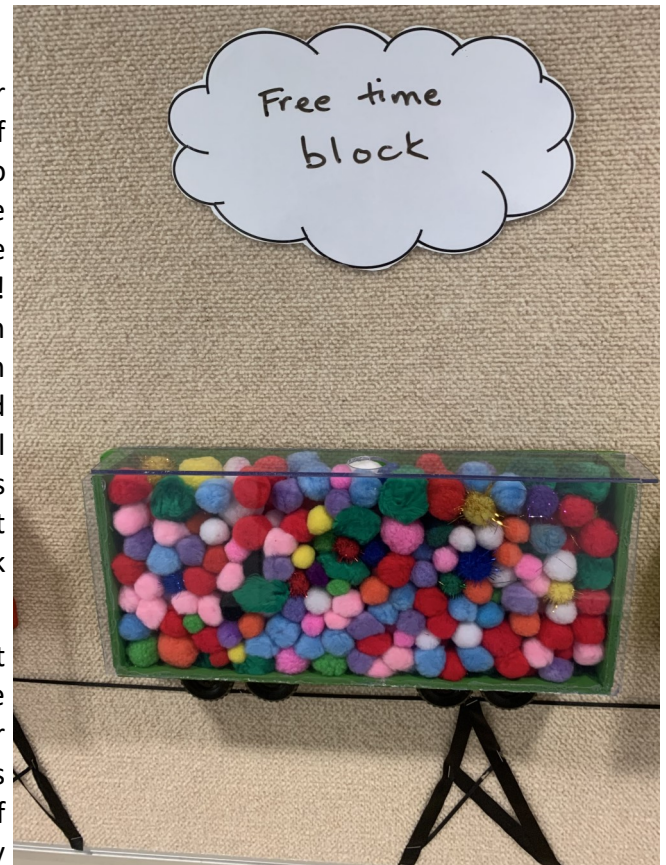

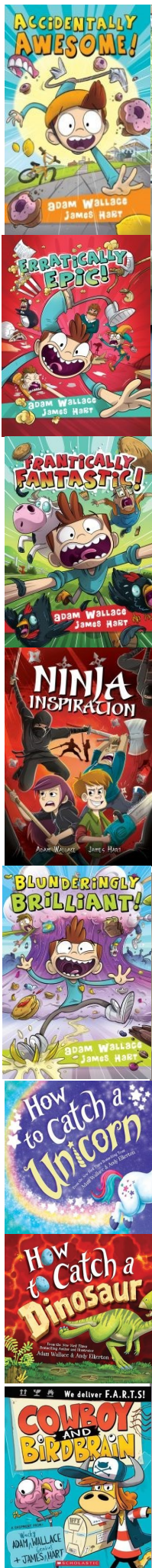

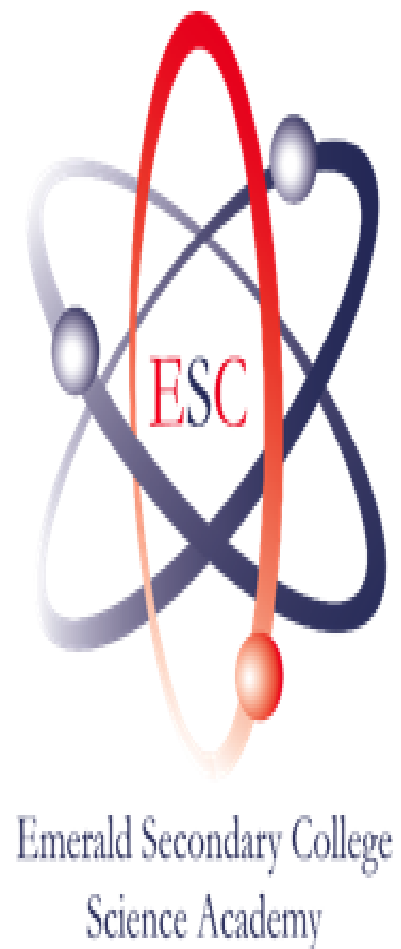
Emerald Secondary College Science Academy is now open for applications for Year 7's in 2021.
