PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Term 2 Curriculum Day for next Wednesday has been cancelled.

Wednesday 23 June is a normal school day

It was wonderful last Friday to see students return to their classrooms with such positivity. Students slipped straight back into the school environment and you could see the excitement as they reconnected with their friends. We have been so proud of the resilience and optimism of all our students during this period of Remote Learning and wholeheartedly appreciate the efforts of all our parents and carers to ensure students moved smoothly into and then out of Remote Learning practices.

There was plenty of positive feedback from families to our approach to learning through this period of Remote Learning. In planning for 2021 this plan is what we had decided on if a snap lockdown were to occur again. Whilst we hoped that the plans would never be enacted it is a plan that allows us to transition to Remote Learning with short notice. This is the plan in the future which we will enact if required.

After consultation with School Council the decision has been made to cancel the Curriculum day that was planned for next Wednesday. After the recent lockdown I felt that it best to support families by not asking working parents to possibly take a day off given that things are just returning to 'normal' after the last couple of weeks. Under current COVID guidelines we are also unable to attend other schools at this time which was planned for staff on the day. The curriculum day will be rescheduled for later in the year.


