Safety measures

QR codes and record keeping

The use of Service Victoria QR codes for electronic record keeping is now mandatory in all schools to enable the effective contact tracing of any COVID-19 cases. This requirement will continue into Term 3 until further notice.

QR code check ins are required to be used by:

- All visitors on school site (including contractors, external Department staff and building and maintenance staff)
- All parents who enter school buildings when on school site. (Parents are only allowed to enter the school office, they are not allowed to enter classrooms).

QR code check ins are not required to be used by:

- Students
- Parents who come onto school grounds for drop off or pick up, and do not enter buildings.

Excursions, Incursions, Camps, School Tours, Transition Programs and Assemblies (Please note this information may change as directed by the Department of Education and Training)

- School camps and overnight stays can take place across Victoria with no travel restrictions
- Drinking fountains can remain open
- School tours should not be conducted on-site for prospective students and their families at this time
- Incursions are not permitted at this time
- Excursions are permitted with students from a single school only
- Non-essential meetings, and all school events, gatherings and assemblies should be deferred or held remotely
- Kinder to Prep and Year 6 to Year 7 transition programs are not permitted at this time.

Face masks in schools

Please see the coronvairus.vic.gov.au website for the latest face mask requirements as advice may change at short notice.

As directed by the Victorian Chief Health Officer, from 11.59pm Thursday 15 July:

- Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are not required to wear face masks when at school, or when attending an OHSC program.
- For communication purposes, teachers and education support staff are not required to wear face masks while teaching, but those who wish to do so, can. It is recommended that face masks be worn while teaching wherever practicable.

The wellbeing of all our students is our priority and our school staff and teachers are here to support you and your family. Information that might be of assistance to you in talking to your child about COVID-19 is available. If you are concerned about your wellbeing or that of your child, please contact the school so we can talk with you about how we can best assist. Other sources of support include: Parent Line 13 22 89 and Kids Helpline 1800 55 1800.

A reminder that if you, your child, or a family member develops symptoms of COVID-19, you should get tested at a COVID-19 testing facility and stay home.

Each family should regularly check the list of public exposure sites in Victoria (where a person with COVID-19 has attended), and if anyone in the family has attended a site at the times listed, follow the instructions given.

As has been the experience before, the guidelines will become either stricter or more relaxed depending on how Victoria comes out of this lockdown. We are fairly certain that what we have is locked in for the next few weeks and we encourage everybody to follow the guidelines of the Chief Health Officer so that we can get back normal as soon as possible.

PRODUCTION

Given the restrictions that we are currently operating with the decision has been made to film this years Production. The ongoing uncertainty around lockdowns, density limits and venue availability has led us to this decision.



Obviously this is disappointing not to be performing in front of an audience but we know from last years experience that filming offers a fantastic opportunity for the students to still participate in Production. Currently we are investigating some options to screen the show and DVD copies of the performance will be able to be purchased.

CURRICULUM DAY

Each year all Victorian Government Schools are allocated 4 curriculum days to use for professional learning and/or undertaking other work that cannot be undertaken on other school days. These days are extremely important to all schools, as they are an opportunity to work together as a whole staff to build our knowledge and understanding of new and emerging teaching and learning approaches. Like all professions, teachers must constantly update their knowledge and continue to build new skills that respond the needs of students.

The Curriculum Day next Friday August 6 will proceed as planned. We have already once postponed it after the last lockdown. Staff have been working throughout the term on developing our teaching of writing and the day will allow us to again focus on this work. No students are required at school on this day.

THE 2021 PARENT OPINION SURVEY

The Parent Opinion Survey is issued annually by the Department of Education and Training and is conducted amongst a sample of randomly selected parents at every school in Victoria. This year I have allowed all families the opportunity to participate. All responses to the survey are anonymous. The survey helps our school gain an understanding of how you view our school climate, student engagement and the teaching and learning programs. Our school will use the results to inform school planning and improvement strategies.

The survey will be conducted online, only takes 10-15 minutes to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English. The survey is open until Sunday 22nd August. Results will be sent back to our school at the end of September.
