5/6S - Amelia J - Respect

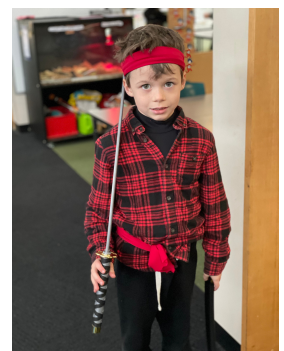
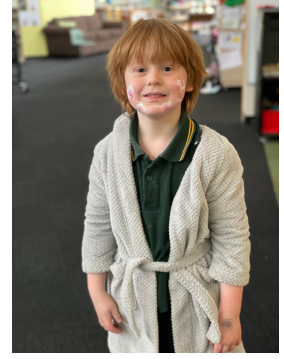
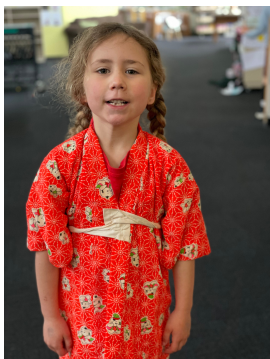
