DIVISION SOCCER





Catherine Manning Parenting Seminar, presented by the PFA

On Friday 28th July, the PFA was delighted to present a seminar with Catherine Manning from SEED Workshops. There was so much info to take in, and the one-hour seminar could easily have gone for three hours!

We learnt about social media and body image, gender bias, respectful relationships, consent, dealing with conflict in our relationships, and connecting with our kids. Some key takeaways were:

- When our kids are overwhelmed, we can teach them that they are in control and help them to take notice of what feelings are coming up.
- One strategy to help kids deal with conflict is SOS: Stop. Observe. Steer.
- This means STOP to take a moment, OBSERVE and reflect on what you're feeling in that moment, and then STEER the conversation/conflict in a positive direction. Parents can teach this by modelling it themselves during conflict with kids or partners. (But easier said than done this stuff is hard!)

Some statistics about gender, body image and mental health that were shared by Catherine, include:

- 85% of women and 79% of girls opt out of activities if they don't feel good about the way they look.
- Children are exposed to 5,000 photoshopped images a week. Most adults understand that these images aren't real but children don't have that ability yet, so parents play an important role in demystifying this.
- 90% of young people have seen pornography by 12 years old.
- Both boys and girls can struggle with negative issues around their own body image.
- It's important for parents to work on their own body confidence and the inner voice that tells them they aren't good enough so they can model body positivity to their kids.
- Because of traditional gender norms fathers often start withdrawing affection from male children early on, and this negatively impacts boys who may find it harder to seek and feel affection as adults.
- The 'man box' we put males in greatly limits boys' potential. This is a narrow version of what a 'man' can be, and it reduces and damages the mental health and self-worth of boys.

Catherine also gave us some ideas about how to improve our relationships with our kids. Some of These ideas are:

- Give your kids 'Love Dump' days. Every now and then, plan one-on-one days with your child and do their favourite things.
- Don't lecture them ask them questions. Kids are smart. Their answers will likely show you they understand more than you realise.
- Listen.
- During conflict, use 'I words' to express how you feel, rather than attack them for what they did.
- Take responsibility if you need to.
- Affirm how they're feeling, and forgive.
- Forget the past and focus on now.
- Always end a conversation or conflict on a positive note.
