Staffing update

SVT Changes

Progress reports

This year we have opted to add progress reports to our reporting cycle. Progress reports will provide a snapshot of your child's learning behaviours in the first 6 weeks of school. Students will be assessed on effort/attitude, listening, managing time, personal organisation and working with others. Reports will be released to parents on Wednesday 13th March 2024. Parents will then have an opportunity to discuss these with their child's teacher/s at Parent Teacher Conferences on Wednesday 20th March. You will still receive your traditional semester report at the end of Term 2 and Term 4.

NAPLAN 2024

NAPLAN (National Assessment Program- Literacy & Numeracy) is taking place for Years 3 & 5 students in weeks 7 and 8 this term. NAPLAN is a point-in-time assessment, that allows parents and schools to see how students are progressing in literacy and numeracy, against the national standard and compared with their peers throughout Australia. The data from NAPLAN is one of the tools that teachers use to understand your child's progress and plan for their teaching and learning.

Prep 2025

I would like to thank those families who have already enquired about enrolling their children for next year. If you have a child starting Prep in 2025 you will need to complete an online application form through the Department of Education. This is a new process this year and further information will be released at the start of Term 2. Additionally, if you know of a family in our local area who plans to send their child to Selby in 2025, please encourage them to organise a tour.

Curriculum Day

Just a reminder that we have rescheduled our Curriculum Day for this Friday 8th March (no students at school this day). During the day, teachers will be involved in a variety of rich activities and will focus on highlighting the science of reading. Teachers will also visit Tinternvale Primary School in Croydon to see different models for the teaching of literacy.

PERFORMING ARTS


What a wonderful start to the year we have had in Performing Arts. Thank you to all Selby Primary School students for their enthusiasm and engagement in Music.






PERFORMING ARTS










JUNIOR SCHOOL INCURSION HR HUFF

A hugely successful first outing together!












