#### **Capital Works**

The time has come to farewell our much-loved shed. The building which is currently used as our garden shed is due for demolition. This building was part of the original school established in the 1950s and was used as our music room for several years. Unfortunately, it does not meet modern bushfire regulations and the Department of Education has included us on their annual demolition list. You will start to see temporary fencing up around the school from next with the demolition due in mid-May.

#### Foundation (Prep) Enrolment Process 2025

This year our school will use an online system for new enrolments All primary schools in Inner East and Outer East areas of the North East Victoria Region are using this online system.

The online system will be available for parents who are applying to enrol their child in Foundation (Prep). An application form can be completed on laptops, PC's and mobile phones. The online system will also allow you to upload documented proof of residential address.

It is important to note that the placement policy is followed by all government schools. Your chances of being offered a place in the schools you apply for are not advantaged or disadvantaged by using this system.

Victorian government school enrolments for Foundation (Prep) for the 2025 school year will open on Monday 15 April 2024, the start of Term 2. Families are asked to submit enrolment applications by Friday 26 July 2024. The link to apply for a place online at this school will be available from the beginning of Term 2 (April 15).

Prior to April 15, you can indicate your interest in enrolling in our school by leaving your contact details, mobile and email address, with the office We will email the link to you when the system becomes available


