#### **Attitudes to School Survey**

This term, students from Years 4 – 6 will complete the annual Attitudes to School Survey.

The survey assists schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experiences of school. Our school will use the survey results to plan programs and activities to improve your child's schooling experience.

Your child will complete the survey online during school hours using a purpose-built secure online survey tool. It is important to note that we are not in any way "testing" your child. All responses to the survey are kept anonymous. Personal identification data will not be recorded in the survey response file. This ensures that the confidentiality of your child's responses is protected at all times.

This year the Attitudes to School survey will be conducted at our school from the week of Monday, May 20th - Friday, June 14th. The survey only takes 20 minutes to complete and occurs in your child's class.

#### **NAPLAN** Testing and Results

Last Monday we were able to access the preliminary results of the NAPLAN testing that was undertaken by our students in Years 3 and 5 earlier this year. The final results which will be available to parents of Years 3 and 5 students will occur in the week commencing Monday 15th July.

The results of our Years 3 and 5 students were provided in the areas of spelling, reading, numeracy, grammar and punctuation at this stage and are very positive. The writing results will be made available to schools later this term.

Great work!


#### 5/6S - James W - Confidence

Super proud of them all!









We went to the Puffing Billy museum. We saw a train/bike and the first train. Its name was 3A and it was 124 years old. By Jack










