We can't wait to see what this new team will do for Selby Primary!





We finish off the day with some Inquiry. At the moment we're asking big questions about life in our galaxy!








We have had a wonderful semester at Selby Primary School. It has been wonderful to see students showing our school values **Personal Best, Resilience, Respect** and **Confidence**.
