Morning Drop off and Afternoon Pick Up

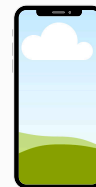
Just a quick reminder that the end of the school day is 3:30pm, with students expected to be picked up at this time. The staff will be on duty to supervise the students being picked up in the carpark to ensure their safety, but it is becoming more common practice that students are remaining in the school grounds to play well after this time. After 3:45pm, the yard is no longer supervised, and it is expected that all students will have a parent/carer with them if they are playing in the yard. Our beautiful facilities are available for use after school, as long as there is adult supervision as our staff will no longer be available.

In the mornings, students are to arrive between 8:45 - 9:00am as once again, this is when our yard is supervised by staff.

If you need to drop your child(ren) off before 8:45am or you are unable to pick up your child(ren) until after 3:45pm, we offer before and after school care in the hall through Camp Australia. Please contact the office for more information.

Mobile Phones and Smart Devices
