Class Placements for 2025

We have started the process of teacher and student placements for 2025. This is a complex process involving a range of factors and allocations. Student and teacher placements will not be finalised until later in the school year, with each staff member working through a comprehensive process to form classes for the new year. Current teaching teams (including specialist teachers) develop prospective lists based on their knowledge of the students about their academic, social/emotional and physical needs.

I wish to offer parents an opportunity to provide, in writing, any special considerations in terms of particular educational needs their child/ren may have, in line with school policy. Please be aware that we will consider all requests but make no guarantees that all requests will be met. Please note that specific requests for teachers will not be considered. Any specific requests from parents regarding the placement of their child/ren must be in writing and emailed to the office at: selby.ps@education.vic.gov.au by no later than Friday 25th October 2024. It is essential to have requests in by this date to assist with planning, staffing and organisation. Unfortunately, late requests will not be considered.

School Swimming

Water Safety in schools is an essential part of any school curriculum. This year's swimming program for the whole school will provide a swimming and water safety skill foundation for children that will enable them to enjoy aquatic activities and link with the Victorian curriculum safely. The program will include water safety knowledge, stroke techniques and continuous basic survival sequences.

This term we will be running a 5-week Swimming program commencing on Tuesday October 29th and concluding Tuesday December 3rd (excluding Nov 5th, Melbourne Cup day). The program will be held at the same pool as last year - Aquatic Achievers in Ferntree Gully.

What a brilliant start to Term 4 you are having Rory. The focus and kindness that you have shown in class has been amazing. Keep up the beautiful respect.


5/6S - Alistair M - Confidence

This term the Preps are learning about science through their senses. The Preps have been busy scientists completing observations, experiments and reporting on their findings. Students used their five senses to go on a scavenger hunt with their buddies. When learning about time in maths the Preps explored day vs night with an experiment using their shadows.



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In Performing Arts we will be exploring a new artist/band each fortnight to develop students listening skills and analysis of music. This past fortnight, we have been listening to Coldplay and discussing the range of sounds that they achieve with only four musicians. Each class from Year 1-6 has been tasked with selecting their favourite Coldplay song to bring to class. The Year 3/4s will be making music analysis posters that will be on display in the hallways sharing their knowledge.



In Year 1/2 students have been writing their own original composition in small groups using rhythm and pitch with instruments. Students have been working hard in their ensembles to practise their performances, learning how to play with accuracy and with dynamic variation. We have been having lots of fun. Keep up the fantastic work Year 1/2s. Their final performance opportunity will take place in the next fortnight.
